The Dartmoor Hunt have the right to refuse entry or request departure from the premises should there be any breach of the Covid-19 protocols put in place.

ANYONE SHOWING ANY SIGNS OF COVID-19 SYMPTOMS SHOULD BE SELF-ISOLATING AND MUST NOT ATTEND THE EVENT.

To comply with “test and trace” all entries must include name, address and telephone number.

Entries will be on a first come first served basis. Once classes are full a waiting list will be maintained. Please include your e mail address to enable us to inform you whether your entry has been accepted or if you have been placed on the waiting list. A full refund will be given to all those remaining on the waiting list. No entries on the day of the show unless you are already pre-entered and there is space in other classes.

IF YOU HAVE NOT PRE-ENTERED ENTRY TO THE SHOWGROUND WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.

Once you have pre-entered you will be given your number which you can print yourself or collect at the show. Vehicles must be parked with a minimum 3 metre distance between each vehicle.

Everyone attending the show is responsible for the maintaining the current social distancing rules.

Please be aware toilets will not be cleaned after every use, however, sanitising and disinfectant spray will be provided. There will also be hand sanitisers by the secretaries
